Road to Hire promotes economic justice for under-resourced young adults in Atlanta, Austin, Charlotte and Richmond through training and on-ramps to sustainable tech careers.

Students spend six months in full-time paid training with Road to Hire to jump-start careers in technology. Throughout the program, students learn technical and professional development skills that build lifelong habits for success. Road to Hire's employer partners meet that hard work with opportunity by hiring Road to Hire graduates into full-time jobs upon graduation.

Since 2016, Road to Hire has graduated 200+ students from it's tech apprenticeships with the help of employer partners.

One-on-One Mentorship:
